She treated children in need of a variety of services, including strengthening exercises, balance/coordination activities, gait training, orthotic fittings/training, functional mobility, and sensory integration activities. To follow in 2018, she completed a 15-week internship within the Neonatal/Pediatric Intensive Care Units where she treated neonates (26-40 weeks old) and children with a variety of services, including infant massage, developmental care (handling/ positioning), feeding interventions, passive range of motion, crutch training, and parent education. Following graduation, she became a Schroth-Barcelona Certified Physical Therapist where she treated children, adolescents, and adults diagnosed with scoliosis.
